The Governor in Council on the report and recommendation of the Minister of Municipal Affairs dated the 7th day of July, A.D. 1967 and pursuant to Section 17 of the Rural Fire District Act, is pleased to:

- (a) declare that on and after the 1st day of August, 1967, the area hereinafter described shall be a fire protection district within the meaning of the Rural Fire District Act, Chapter 9 of the Acts of 1963;
- (b) define the boundaries of the district as follows:

COMMENCING at the intersection of the boundary line between the southern limits of the Town of Bridgewater and the Community of Dayspring with the eastern shore line of the LaHave River;

THENCE along the said Town boundary to the eastern boundary of the C.N.R. right of way;

THENCE along the C.N.R. right of way to the north eastern side of the Oak Hill Road;

THENCE in a straight line to the intersection of the Bollivar Road and the Leary Road;

THENCE in a straight line to the intersection of a hauling road and the Mullock Road, lying west of Smith Mountain, so called;

THENCE in a straight line to the intersection of another hauling road and the main unpaved road which runs northerly from Spectacle Lakes, the last mentioned point being opposite the south west end of Dares Lake;

THENCE in a southerly direction along the eastern side of the said main unpaved road which leads north from Spectacle Lakes to Highway No. 3 and continuing in a straight line on the other side of the highway to the intersection of the Grimm Road and the Crouse Settlement Road;

THENCE along the southerly margin of the properties originating on the southerly side of the Crouse Settlement Road to the properties on the east side of Highway No. 32;

THENCE in a southerly direction along the eastern margin of the properties on the east side of Highway No. 32 to and including the property (now or formerly of Paul Wakarusa)

THENCE along the southern margin of the Paul Wakefield property to the eastern shore of the LaHave River;

THENCE in a northerly direction along the eastern shore of the LaHave River to the place of beginning;

- (c) prescribe "District of Dayspring" as the name of the District; and
- (d) appoint Vernon Falkenham of Rhodes Corner in the County of Lunenburg; laborer; Milne C. Pickings of Upper LaHave in the said County, Manager and Jock D. Campbell of Upper LaHave aforesaid, retired; to be Commissioners for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of the said Rural Fire District Act.
